Introducing our CSA Farm

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a relationship between our farm and you as our customer. Rather than simply purchasing food, our customers become "members" of this CSA farm who receive a portion of the farm's harvest.

Our CSA runs from 18 weeks from June to October. Members are responsible for showing up at the agreed upon pick up site each week to receive your share of harvested produce.

The products we expect

We promise to do our best to provide you with a bountiful share each week. The quantity of produce however may vary from week to week due to weather, insects and other production factors despite our best efforts. By joining our CSA, you are agreeing to share the risk of crop failure with us and other members. In the unlikely event of a crop failure, we compensate for that crop by filling your share with other crops from our farm that are ready for harvest at that time as best we can. We also have partnerships with other local farmers and may supplement as needed.

You are responsible for observing our drop of site rules as follows:

Pick up your share within the time frame stated. Although we deliver high quality produce to the site, it will decline if not picked up and refrigerated. Please return each week's containers (baskets, quarts, pints, bags and elastics) we recycle.

If you cannot pick up your share let us know. We will donate it for you. You can also arrange for someone else to pick up for you. You are responsible for explaining the location and procedures to your substitute. If you wish to change your drop site, please give us one week's notice. Shares that are not retrieved within the pick up time will be donated to Pelham Cares.

Member Fees

By selling memberships in advance of the growing season, CSA reduces the burden of upfront costs for the farmer. Your membership fees provide us with money to purchase seeds and other equipment before the season starts. We appreciate your commitment.
